a. Young/Future Professional Network

Andy reviewed vision, mission and goals for this network; provided Board with an outline of how this would be accomplished; Discussion followed about how this Board can promote this program; Deb suggested our involvement should include a mentoring piece; Discussed the short-term goal would be to develop a mentoring program for 3 possible scenarios: a graduating college senior ready to enter the profession; a brand new hire or a rising professional. Discussed methods for outreach: 1- Regional meetings held at colleges with student involvement facilitated by faculty member; 2- Board meetings held at local colleges with a presentation about profession, (include time in board agenda for this presentation). Create mentoring program – develop a fillable form or e-mail request sent by regional representatives to inquire who wants to be a mentor and who wants to be mentored. Steve suggested this could be done within two weeks, and then passed on to the reps. Target of Fall Workshop – all reps should have been able to have recruited mentors and this can be announced at Workshop; by November, we can begin recruiting mentees. Deb G will put together Power Point presentation for promoting the profession and the association.
